Greetings from the Secretary/Treasurer:

The girls season is up and running. I have received several invitational results and hope to receive more. Keep in mind that you can email me with these results and as soon as we make the changes to the website, we will begin posting these results as well as sending them via the email newsletters. I have received several membership requests in recent days. Please remember to keep me updated on any coaching changes. If I do not hear anything I cannot make the needed changes. Direct non-member coaches to the website where they can find a form which will get them registered with the association. Once I have received the \$10 membership dues, a coach is a full member and is eligible for all of the benefits of the association. As always, email me if you have any questions or concerns.

Membership benefits of the IHSGCA:

Your membership dues allow the IHSGCA to do the following things throughout the year.

Biweekly newsletters: The IHSGCA sends biweekly e-newsletters throughout the boys and girls golf seasons. These newsletters inform coaches on issues related to the season. Invitational updates, rules changes, awards information and other coaching related items are all part of each issue.

A yearly coaches clinic: The IHSGCA provides a fall clinic to give an opportunity for coaches from around the state to connect allowing discussion on the issues important to high school and junior golf.

A spring and fall awards banquet: The IHSGCA works in conjunction with the IGA to honor the all-state teams as well as deserving coaches who have worked to promote junior golf. As an association we honor players and coaches with the following awards each year.

Boys and Girls All-State Team: This award is given to the top 15 players in the state based on a point system that recognizes invitational play, regular season play and state tournament play.

Boys Academic All-State: This award is give to the top 15 senior varsity players. In order to be nominated the player must meet the following minimum standards: a GPA of 3.5, an core SAT score of 1000 or equivalent ACT score, and rank in the top 15% of their class.

Girls Academic All-State: This award is similar to the boys award but is handled by the Indiana Coaches of Girls Sports Association. You must be a member of the ICGSA to nominate for this award. Please check their website for the actual requirements.

Boys Coach of the Year: This award is presented to an IHSGCA member coach who in the eyes of their peers has achieved the highest status within the coaching ranks. This awards is a reflection of the entire season. A state tournament showing is a plus but not required to win this award. The ICGSA honors the Girls Coach of the Year every March.

Indiana Golf Coaches Hall of Fame: The IHSGCA seeks to honor those who have contributed significantly to junior golf over his/her career. Those who obtain this honor are recognized with a plaque in the Hall of Fame at the IGA office in Franklin.

Distinguished Service Award: This award is presented to an IHSGCA member coach(s) who have gone “beyond the call of duty” to promote junior golf either in their school, community, the IHSGCA or the state of Indiana. The recipient(s) of this award symbolize outstanding dedication and/or service to junior golf.

The Mitchel J. Winger Courage Award: This award is give to a varsity player (boys and girls) who contributes to the success of their team despite of physical impairments and/or medical conditions. The focus of this award is on the players accomplishments not on the specific “handicaps”.

Most importantly, the IHSGCA provides a voice for all of the high school coaches around the state in the decisions being made by the IHSAA. Your membership allows us to speak to the IHSAA with the power of over 400 coaches representing over 300 high schools. Our ability to get the word out to so many coaches is noticed and does enter into every decision they make. It is not possible to please every program and every coach. However, our voice insures that every voice is heard.
